

Privacy Policy

Information we collect from you

To carry out our obligations arising from any contracts entered into between us and to provide you with the information, products and services that you request from us; To provide you with information about other goods and services we offer that are similar to those that you have already purchased or enquired about; To provide you, or permit selected third parties to provide you, with information about goods or services we feel may interest you. To notify you about changes to our service;

To ensure that content from our site is presented in the most effective manner for you and for your computer.
